Furthermore, she has recent faculty experience in a Magnet facility to develop a professional practice model, implement quality measures, build partnerships to bridge academia and practice, expand leadership capacity, and manage change.

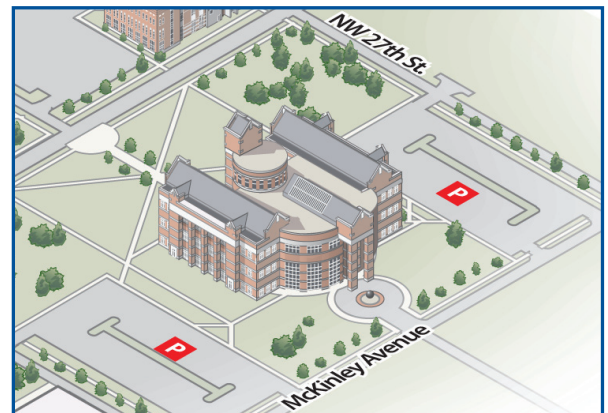
## Hotel Information
